Making a Strong Password
<ul> <li>Make the password longer</li> <li>Use short phrases</li> <li>May require upper and lower case letters</li> <li>May require numbers and symbols</li> </ul>

One of the most important things you can do to keep your account secure is to choose a strong password or one that is hard to guess.

What makes a strong password? You can make the passwords longer by using short phrases like "cows help make cheese." Remember, many websites have requirements for passwords. These requirements are usually listed underneath the password field or identified once you click on the password field. The password may be required to have upper and lowercase letters, numbers, and symbols.

When creating a strong password, don't include common words like "password" or personal information like your address or name. Don't use the same password on every website. If you think your computer has had a virus or one of your accounts was broken into or compromised, you should change to a new password.

If you've used the internet for a while, you may create a lot of accounts on many different websites or mobile apps. Your usernames and passwords may be different on each site so it can be a challenge to remember them. There are several options for keeping track of your passwords.



You could choose to write them down in a notebook. If you do this, make sure to store the notebook in a safe and secure place.

You may choose to use a secure password management mobile app or website that can help keep track of your user IDs, passwords, security questions and other information for your accounts. These programs are usually unlocked with a single master password and then allow you to access all your passwords when you need them.
